As per the Govt. Order No. ක්ෂක 83, ක්ෂක 2013, නීගේෂයෝ, 2013, නීගේෂයෝ, න: 29.6.2013, Principals of the affiliated colleges of the Bangalore University are not supposed to demand the prescribed fee from SC/ST students of Karnataka.

Those Students have to submit the Post-Matric Scholarship application through online in the State Scholarship Portal (SSP), Govt of Karnataka. The Social /Tribal Welfare Department will reimburse the fees to the University. The Chairpersons of the University.

Principals of the Affiliated Colleges shall instruct the eligible SC/ST students of Karnataka to submit their Post- Metric Scholarship application (on which the photo of the students and 12 digit UUCMS Registration number is displayed) in the SSP without fail. (The Social / Tribal Welfare Department will reimburse the fees to the University A/c, if the Student is pursuing the respective course in the University Departments and to the Principals A/c, if the student is pursuing the respective course in the Affiliated Colleges. If in case, the SSP reimburse the fees to the students account (DBT), students who have availed the fee concession shall be directed to remit the balance fee amount.)

Those students who do not fulfill the attendance requirement shall not be permitted to take the Examination at any circumstances and the application of those students shall not be entertained.

Even though if the SC/ST students of Karnataka whose parents annual income is less then are equal to 2.5lakhs and he/she have not applied for Post-Matric Scholarship in the respective Departments, during the previous year of study, he/she would have paid the prescribed course fee at the time of admission for the present year in full. Hence those student shall pay the full examination fee prescribed by the University. Thereafter, if the scholarship is sanctioned to the students by the Social/Tribal welfare Department, the same will be reimbursed to the Affiliated college student/University Student by the college authorities/Office of Director Student's welfare respectively. Apart from these SC/ST students, remaining SC/ST students shall pay the concession fee of Rs. 15/- and submit the photocopies of the following documents.

- Caste Certificate of the Student issued by the Tahsildar.
- 4. Parents' Annual Income Certificate (less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/-) issued by the Tahsildar (valid up to 5 years).

Note:- The Principals of the Affiliated Colleges are directed to submit the above documents along with Financial Statement, Fee paid Receipts to the PG Preparatory Section.

The Principals of the Affiliated Colleges shall submit list of SC/ST Students who paid concession fees in the following format.

Further, the students may be directed to apply for Scholarship in the SSP and a copy acknowledgement for having applied may be submitted to the concerned Principals of the respective Affiliated Colleges are directed to inform those students who have not submitted the acknowledgement to remit the prescribed Course/ Examination fee in full (Balance fee to be paid) to the University funds and submit the receipts to the College.

In case of non-receipt of Scholarship / Fee reimbursement of a particular student from the Social Welfare Department for the reasons mentioned therein by the Department, the student shall be directed to pay the prescribed admission & other fees, odd and even semester Examination fee before appearing for the next Semester Examination.

The Principals of the respective Affiliated Colleges are informed that the Marks cards of the students who are liable to pay the balance fee to the University shall not be issued and any application submitted by those students shall not be forwarded until the balance are cleared. It is the responsibility of the concerned College authorities to get the balance fees deposited to the University funds from the students.

The fee reimbursement is not applicable to SC/ST students who are repeaters and from other states. Such students shall remit the Examination fee prescribed by the University in full. Further the students who belong to Cat-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB and Minorities shall pay the prescribed fee in full.

The Principals of Colleges shall ensure that the students whose admissions are not approved by the University / having shortage of attendance, such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the Examination.

As per rules, a student has to satisfy a minimum 75% of attendance in each subject out of 90 working days in each semester to become eligible to appear for the Examination.

Students who satisfy the above 75% attendance requirement, during the current semester shall be allowed to appear for the ensuing Examination. Those students, who do not satisfy the above mandate, shall not be issued Hall Tickets by the Chairpersons of the Departments / Principals of the concerned Colleges.

Payment of Examination fee and submission of application for the Examination alone do not entitle a student to take the Examination, if he/she is not eligible as per Rules / Regulations governing the eligibility, viz., Approval of Admissions / Shortage of Attendance etc.

The Internal Assessment/Grading (as applicable) shall be submitted through On-line on or before 29-10-2022 to the University website www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in using the same Password given previous year, and also hard copy of the Internal Assessment/Grading (as applicable) should also be submitted on or before 29-10-2022 to the Registrar (Evaluation), Pareeksha Bhavan Jnana Bharathi Bangalore-560 056, without fail.

The application forms may be obtained from the Principals of the concerned colleges. The applications with necessary enclosures and the fee paid Receipt/Copies of the Marks Cards of Previous Examination should be submitted to the concerned Colleges within the late date mentioned above.

The Principals of the Institutions are requested to send applications to the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation), "Pareeksha Bhavan", Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore - 560 056, along with candidates list including repeaters in FOUR SETS of the respective Examination and Subject-wise statement in Triplicate along with Online Receipt on or before 29-10-2022 The Principal should not allow the candidates whose admissions are not approved by the University to write the Examination.

1. All such candidates shall study and pass the examination/subject/paper as per the existing syllabus of their respective schemes only.

2. All such candidates should contact the chairperson of Department of

Education Bangalore University for equivalent subject/s.

3. The candidates who have completed the course and failed in all subject/papers in each semester are eligible to appear for examinations.

4. The candidates who have discontinued the course are not-eligible to appear in this onetime measure scheme.

Question paper requirement along with one set of candidate list shall be submitted to the Confidential Section directly on or before 29-10-2022 failing which, penal fee of Rs.5, 000/- will be levied for late submission.

Please note that if the candidates list and applications are not received within the date as enumerates Centre Declaration will not be made by this office for conduct of Examination to the students of such Colleges.
