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It is brought to the notice of candidates appearing for Ed IV<sup>th</sup> Semesters Freshers & Repeaters examination of B.P.Ed (CBCS) course to be held in the month of September/October-2021, that they have to pay the following examination fees. The last dates for payment of examination fees and submission of duly filled Pre-printed examination application forms are as detailed below:

The Principals of the concerned college are request to Entry the <u>examination</u> <u>application forms</u> from Online Portal of Bangalore University, The candidates are request to pay the required examination fees Online, submit the same to their respective college Principals on the same day of payment of examination fees. The candidates may also make a photo copy of the duly filled application forms and obtain an acknowledgement on the photocopy from their respective Principals for having submitted the application to the college. This photocopy should be produced to the University for any Clarification. No examination application form will be accepted after the due date under any circumstances.

The candidates are required to pay the following prescribed examination fees online as per the list enclosed.

Convocation degree certificate fee to be collected only from the students who are appearing for final semester (For all categories of students of Bangalore University).

As per the Govt. Order No. ಸಕಇ 83, ಪಕವಿ 2013, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು, 2013, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು, ದಿ: 29.6.2013, Principals of the affiliated colleges of the Bangalore University are not supposed to demand the prescribed fee from SC/ST students of Karnataka. The fees prescribed to be paid by SC/ST students will be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department on submission of On-line Post-Metric applications by the students. The Principals of the concerned colleges shall obtain the reimbursement of fees (which will be remitted to Principal's account in case of students of affiliated Colleges and DSW Account in case of students of Bangalore University DIRECT by CASH TRANSFER from Social Welfare Department) by forwarding on Online Post-Metric applications. Only those students who fulfill the attendance requirement shall be permitted to take the examination. Otherwise Examination application shall not be entertained.

The Principals of the concerned colleges should ascertain that the SC/ST students have submitted the following photocopies of the documents, which are attested by the Gazetted Officer alongwith on-line Post-Metric application (on which the photo of the student and 15 digit Registration Number is displayed)



- a. 'Caste Certificate of the Student issued by the Tahsildar.
- b. Parents' Annual Income Certificate (less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/-) issued on or after 01.04.2012 by the Tahsildar which is valid up to 5 years. (If the parent of the student is a State/Central Government Employee, salary slip shall be insisted along with the Income Certificate).
- c. Previous year Marks Card / Result Sheet.
- d. Student's Bank A/c. Passbook (Front sheet with photo of the student, IFSC Code, etc.,)

If, the above documents are found to be enclosed along with on-line Post-Metric application and forwarded to the Social Welfare Department, the Principal shall collect Rs 15/- per OMR Sheet notified by the University. On receipt of the post metric scholarship online application.

The Principals of the concerned Colleges shall remit the Examination fee of SC/ST students reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department along with the Statement showing the details of students viz., Name, Course, Semester, Social Welfare Scholarship Registration No., Date of Birth to the University on or before <u>01.10.2021</u>

The Principals of the concerned Colleges shall submit the statement of SC/ST students mentioning their Name, Course, Semester, Social Welfare Scholarship Registration No., Date of Birth to the University along with the Examination OMR Sheets on or before <a href="https://doi.org/10.2021">01.10.2021</a>

In case of non-receipt of Scholarship / Fee reimbursement of a particular student from the Social Welfare Department for the reasons mentioned therein by the department, the student shall be directed to pay the prescribed IV<sup>th</sup> semester Examination fees before appearing for the next semester Examination.

The fee reimbursement for SC/ST students is not applicable for repeaters and SC/ST students of other states. Such students shall remit the Examination fee prescribed by the University.

Cat-I, 2A, 2B, 3A & 3B and other students shall remit the **Whole Examination fee + add** prescribed by the University.

Cat-I students whose Parents' Annual Income is less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/-and students belonging to Category 2A, 3A & 3B whose Parents' Annual Income is less than or equal to Rs.100,000/- are eligible to apply for the reimbursement from Backward Classes Welfare Department. The reimbursement of fees will be credited by the Backward Classes Welfare Department to students' account DIRECT by CASH TRANSFER, only to such student who are eligible as per the Guidelines of the Backward Classes Welfare Department.



The students (non professional courses) belonging to minorities i.e., Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, etc., whose Parents' Annual Income is less than or equ. to Rs.44,500/- and who have applied for Financial Support from Minorities Welfare Department are extended educational financial support of Rs.5,000/- only per Academic year.

A student has to satisfy a minimum 75% of attendance in each subject out of 90 working days in each semester to become eligible to appear for the Examination.

Students who satisfy the above 75% attendance requirement during the current Semester are allowed to appear for the ensuing Examination. Those students, who do not satisfy the above mandatory requirement shall not be issued Hall Tickets by the Principals of the concerned Colleges.

As per the University Circular No.RPS/Fee/2009, dated:12.11.2009, in respect of University Departments / Constituent Colleges students / residing in BBMP area should pay the Examination fees to the University by way of crossed Online only drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of the Finance Officer, Bangalore University, Bangalore and payable only at State Bank of India, Nagarabhavi Branch, Bangalore – 560056. This shall be remitted either at the City Finance Office Cellar Floor, Library Building, Central College Campus, Bangalore – 01 or at the Office of the Finance Officer, Ground Floor, Administrative Building, Jnanabharathi, Bangalore-56 and obtain an official receipt for the same. The said receipt issued as proof of payment of amount shall be enclosed to the intended application compulsorily. Any other form of remittances like Cash, Cheque, IPO, Bank Challans, Money Order, Mail transfer etc., is not accepted.

For Concerned Colleges and students located/residing in places other than BBMP limit area mentioned above, they shall continue to follow the existing practice of remitting fees in State Bank of India branches.

Payment of Examination fee and submission of application for the Examination alone do not entitle a student to take the Examination, if he/she is not eligible as per Rules / Regulations governing the eligibility, viz., Approval of Admissions / Shortage of Attendance etc.

The Examination fee once paid will not be refunded or re-adjusted under any circumstances. The Internal Assessment Marks secured by the candidates shall be displayed atleast one week prior to the last working day of each semester on the Notice Board. The statement of Internal Assessment marks shall be sent to Registrar (Evaluation) on or before 01.10.2021



The practical Examinations for the course wherever prescribed will be notified by the Chief Superintendents of the concerned Colleges.

The application forms may be obtained from the Principals of the concerned colleges. The applications with necessary enclosures and the fee paid Challan/Receipt/Copies of the the date mentioned above.

The Principals of the Institutions are requested to send applications to the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation), "Pareeksha Bhavan", Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore - 560 056, along with candidates list including repeaters of IV<sup>th</sup> Sem. in FOUR SETS of the respective Examination and Subject-wise statement in Triplicate along with Online Receipt on or before <u>01.10.2021</u> The Principal should not allow the candidates whose admission are not approved by the University to write the Examination.

Academic Council resolution dated 17.11.2020 Semester Scheme students who have admitted during 2004-2005 Batch and on wards for U.G. Course and who could not complete their degree within stipulated period as per Bangalore university regulations are permitted to appear for the odd semester examination <u>UNDER ONE TIME MEASURE</u> subject to the following conditions

- 1. All such candidates shall study and pass the examination/subject/paper as per the existing syllabus of their respective schemes only.
- 2. All such candidates should contact the concerned chairperson of the Bangalore university departments for equivalent subject/s.
- 3. The candidates who have completed the course and failed in all subject/papers in each semester are eligible to appear for examinations.
- 4. The candidates who have discontinued the course are not-eligible to appear in this onetime measure seheme.

Question paper requirement along with one set of candidate list shall be submitted to the Confidential Section directly on or before <u>01.10.2021</u> failing which, penal fee of Rs.5,000/- will be levied for late submission.

Please note that if the candidates list and applications are not received within this date, Centre Declaration will not be made by this office for conduct of Examination to the students of such Colleges.

- 1. The Pre-printed duly filled application forms with attestation of the candidate and Principal.
- 2. List of candidates (each set should have course wise, semester wise, scheme wise, fees paid receipt no. amount and date) along with CD in the format prescribed by Bangalore University.



- 3. One set of candidate list to be submitted to the preparatory sections, at Pareeksha Bhavan, Jnana Bharathi Campus on or before <u>01.10.2021</u>
- 4. Question paper requirement along with one set of candidate list should be submitted directly to the confidential section on or before <u>01.10.2021</u>
- 5. Financial statement of Examination fees in triplicate to be submitted to the Finance Officer, Bangalore University, Bangalore.

Question paper indent along with one set of candidate list should be submitted directly to confidential section, Examination branch and Natural Science Block, Dr. Ambedkar Veedhi, Bangalore - 560 001 on or before 01.10.2021 Failing which Rs 5000/-./- (Rupees Five thousand only) will be imposed as penal fee for late submission.

The Principal are requested not to collect the examinations application forms from the student whose admission is not approved by the University for the year 2019-20. and not to forward the same to the University.

No Cheques/ Postal order/Money orders will be accepted towards the examination fee. The examination fees once paid will not be refunded or readjusted under any circumstance.
