The Chairpersons and Principals shall not collect the examination application form the students whose admission are not approved by the University. No students shall be allowed to take the examination after completion of **three academic years** from the date of admission to the course.



A student has to satisfy minimum 75% of attendance in each subject out of 90 working days in the Semester to become eligible to appear for the examination .

Those students, who do not satisfy the above mandate, shall not be issued hall tickets from the Principal of the Affiliated College,

Wherever the Project report is there, the same shall be submitted within one week before the commencement of the Theory Examination (Project Report) is compulsory for Post-Graduate Diploma students otherwise they are not eligible to take theory Examination.
